

Waiver for Student Fees



Tax credit amounts are \$200 for an individual or \$400 for a family.

This is a great way for you to help the school and double your money at the same time! One hundred percent of your donation is a tax credit back to you. The best way to donate this money is directly to benefit your child. In doing so, your money can be used for school activities as well as extracurricular activities. At the end of the school

year, whatever is left will go into a general fund to help with school expenses. So with your maximum family donation of \$400, an example of your child's activities would break out like this:

Basketball Fees:	\$100.00
Drama Club:	\$ 35.00
Field Trip (1):	\$ 7.00
Field Trip (2):	\$ 10.00
Flag Football:	<u>\$150.00</u>
Total on your child:	\$302.00
Total for school:	<u>\$ 98.00</u>
Total donation:	<u>\$400.00</u>

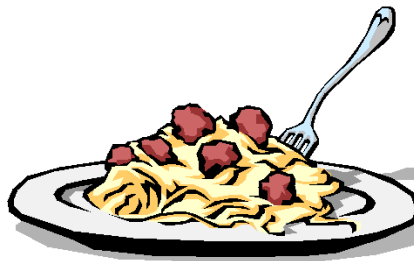
Remember, this is a tax credit. Therefore the school will be sending out the letters stating your participation in the program at the end of January for you to file with your taxes. If you want to wait until January that is fine! The tax credit may not be used for uniforms, lunch money, or planners.

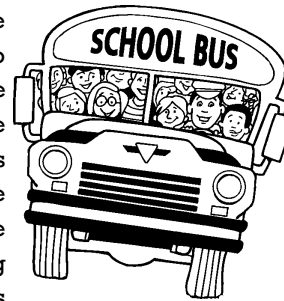

Uniform Policy



In the beginning of this 2010-2011 school year we implemented a new uniform policy. We have allowed a 5 month transition period allowing families

the time and opportunity to acquire the necessary clothing to comply with the new policy. Beginning in January of the new year the uniform policy will be strictly enforced. We understand that the winter months bring about cooler weather and students need to wear jackets to school. Students

are permitted to wear a jacket or sweater in class. However, it must be solid uniform color according to the appropriate grade level (Pre-K-4th navy and hunter green) (5th-8th grade black or burgundy). Absolutely no logos, graphics, or patterns are permitted.
